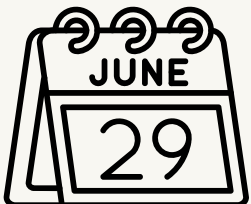

WHAT IS THE CYM PROJECT?

The Children and Youth Matters (CYM) Project is how Strathmore Road Methodist Church lives out its calling to serve the next generation. Our current project launched fully in 2023 and we've seen new life and growing faith in our communities – thanks to the faithful prayers, time, and giving of many people like you. Many of you know that working with children, young people and families has been going on for many, many years here at SRMC and now we're looking to the future.

We believe God is calling us to continue, deepen, strengthen and develop this work. Phase 2 of the project (2026–2031) is rooted in three aspects:

Reach more; Love more; Grow more.



REACH MORE

We want more children, young people, families, and neighbours to experience the good news of Jesus:

- **Reach** more children and young people through our groups and schools work
- **Reach** more parents and grandparents, supporting their journeys
- **Reach** those who are as yet unseen by the Church
- **Reach** into Chopwell Primary school and further develop work there
- **Reach** more people in the River Streets of Chopwell through With Wednesdays
- **Reach** more through large events such as youth ministry nights

LOVE MORE

We want every child and family to feel known, valued and loved, by us and – more importantly – by God.

- Share the **love** of Jesus in this time, in this place with all people across our communities
- **Love** people where they are at, building strong relationships and supporting them to be co-contributors and co-leaders of the work
- Enable each young person, family and community member that we come across to feel **loved** and valued by all of the team
- **Love**, serve and build up our vast volunteer team
- **Love** families through difficult times e.g. bereavement
- **Love** inclusively, for example making our groups more accessible and affirming for neurodivergent children and young people

GROW MORE

We want children and young people not just to attend but to grow into disciples, leaders, and lifelong followers of Christ.

- **Grow** and deepen relationships with those in the community
- Support children, young people and families to **grow** in their faith
- Support families to help their own children **grow** up in a Christian household
- Continue to **grow** the number of families attending our congregations
- **Grow** the number of groups we offer to children and young people beyond Rowlands Gill
- **Grow** and nurture our volunteer teams
- **Grow** detached youth work in Chopwell
- Develop a pathway to **grow** and nurture young leaders
